Re: Inclusion of the Sequence **IIIG** into Appendices **H** and **I** of the
Product Approval Code of Practice – April 2005 Edition

The American Chemistry Council's (ACC) Minor Formulation Modification Work Group (MFMWG) has proposed to the Product Approval Protocol Task Group (PAPTG) to include the Sequence **IIIG** into Appendices **H** and **I**. On April 20, 2005, the PAPTG approved the recommendation to include the Sequence **IIIG** into Appendices **H** and **I**.

Changes to Appendix **H**, Page **H-2**, include "The guidelines listed herein are applicable only to Sequences **IIIF**, **IIIG**, **IVA**, **VG**, **VIB**, and **VIII** engine tests".

Changes to Appendix **I**, Page **I-1**, include "2) The final commercial formulation must contain all minor formulation modifications made for base oil interchangeability testing. For the Sequences **IIIF**, **IIIG**, **IVA**, **VG**, **VIB**, and **VIII** engine tests in the Code, the total number of changes from the tested formulations...".
